Parking at the front of the surgery

We have had a few issues with patients parking on the double yellow lines at the front of the surgery and in front of the doctors parking spots.

Parking on the double yellows (especially the ones on the bend outside the Health Centre next door) can prevent buses from turning the corner which means they have to wait for the parked car to move.

The area in front of the doctors parking spots needs to be always kept clear as the GPs need to be able to access their vehicles so they can get out on their visits to patients.
